

Hooking up your Tunneled Catheter at home for therapy

Supplies

alcohol wipes or antiseptic swabs
clean towel
primed IV tubing
gloves. Gloves are worn if you have a cut, a rash or an infection or
vour hands.

Getting ready

- 1. Wash your hands.
- 2. Put your supplies on a clean towel.
- 3. Prepare the IV bag and tubing.

Hooking up

- Wash hands.
- 2. Put on gloves if needed.
- 3. Clean the connection between the cap and the catheter with an alcohol wipe/swab. Rub with friction for 15 seconds. Allow the alcohol to dry.
- 4. Make sure clamp is closed. Remove the cap.
- 5. Attach the primed IV tubing to your catheter.
- 6. Open the clamp.
- 7. Turn on your IV or pump.
- 8. Secure the catheter as taught.
