Manually Adding M365 MFA - SSPR

Introduction

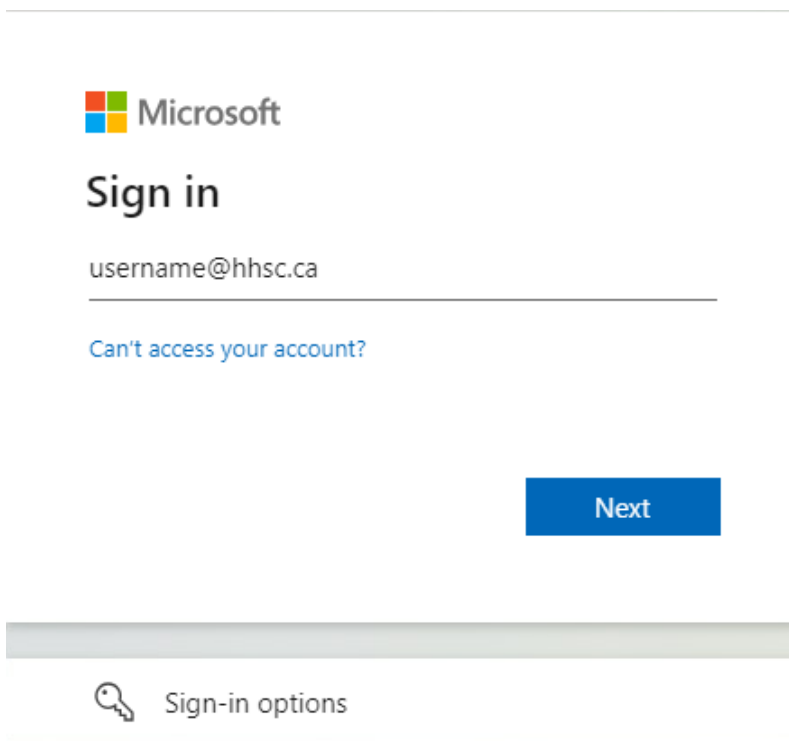
Outlines procedure to manually add Microsoft 365 push-notification Multi-Factor Authentication and phone number for Self-Service Password Reset.

This procedure is to be followed when the automatic onboarding when first signing into Office 365 fails to prompt for registration of Microsoft Authenticator and Self-Service Password Reset.

Procedure

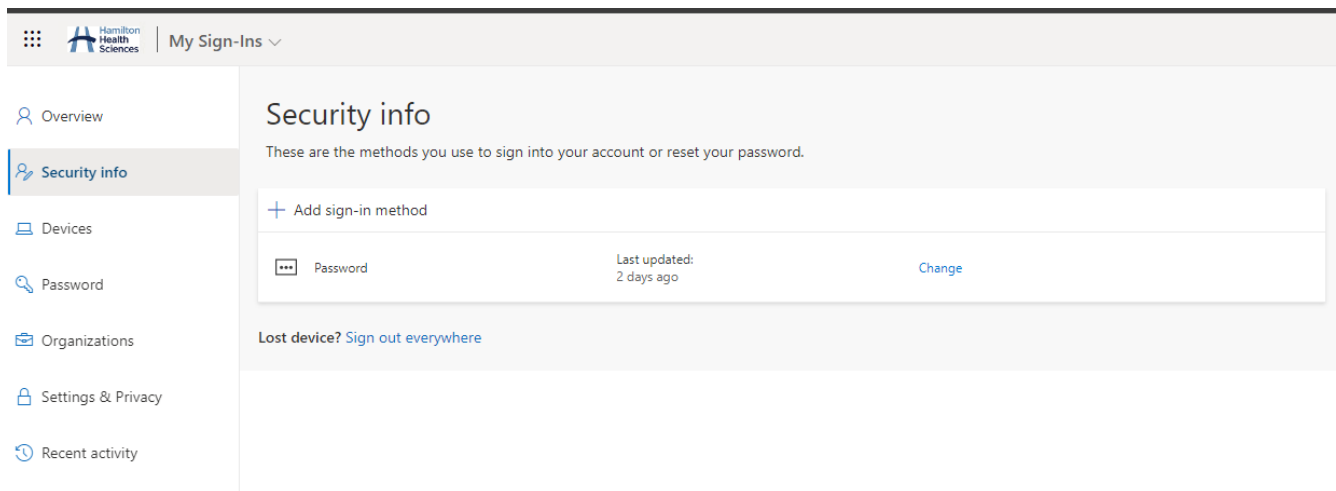
Open a web browser inside of Citrix or while onsite, navigate to <https://mysignins.microsoft.com/security-info>.

Sign in with your HHSC credentials when prompted.

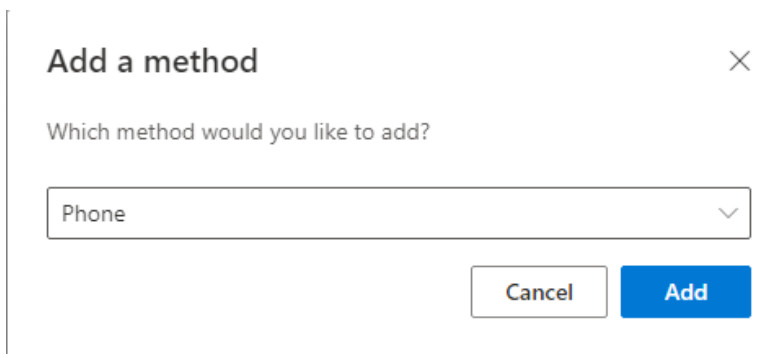




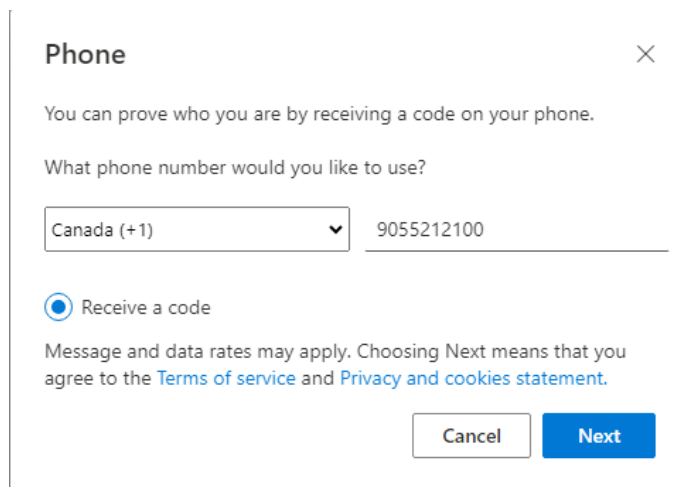
The following screen will appear. Select **Add sign-in method**.



Select **Phone number** as the option.



Add the phone number you will use for your **Self-Service Password Reset** (note this must be a unique phone number, the below is just an example).





On clicking **Next** a code will be sent to the phone number specified. Enter in the 6 digit code received via text message (SMS) and click **Next**.

Back at the main Security Info page, select **Add sign-in method**. This time, select **Authenticator app**, and click **Confirm**.

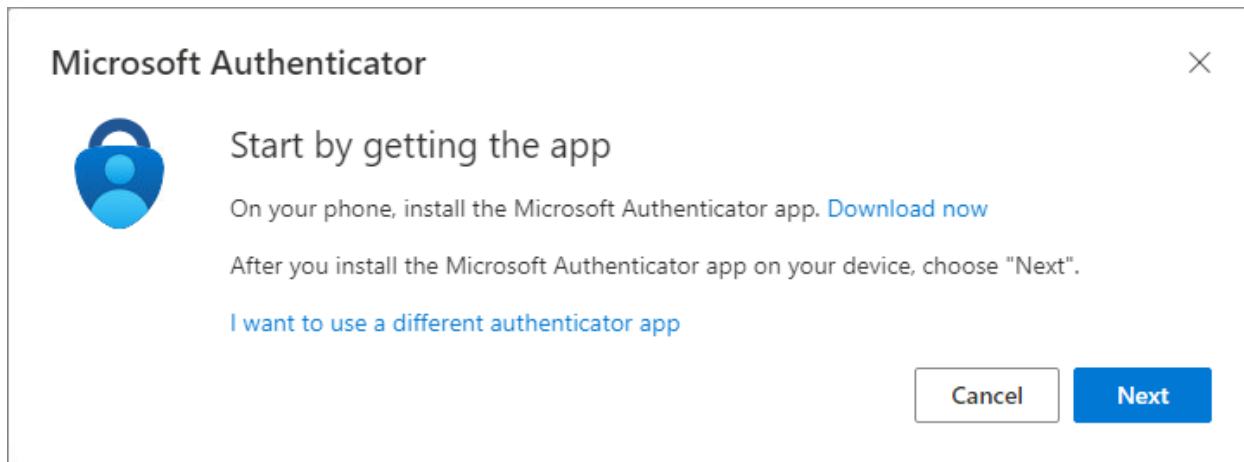

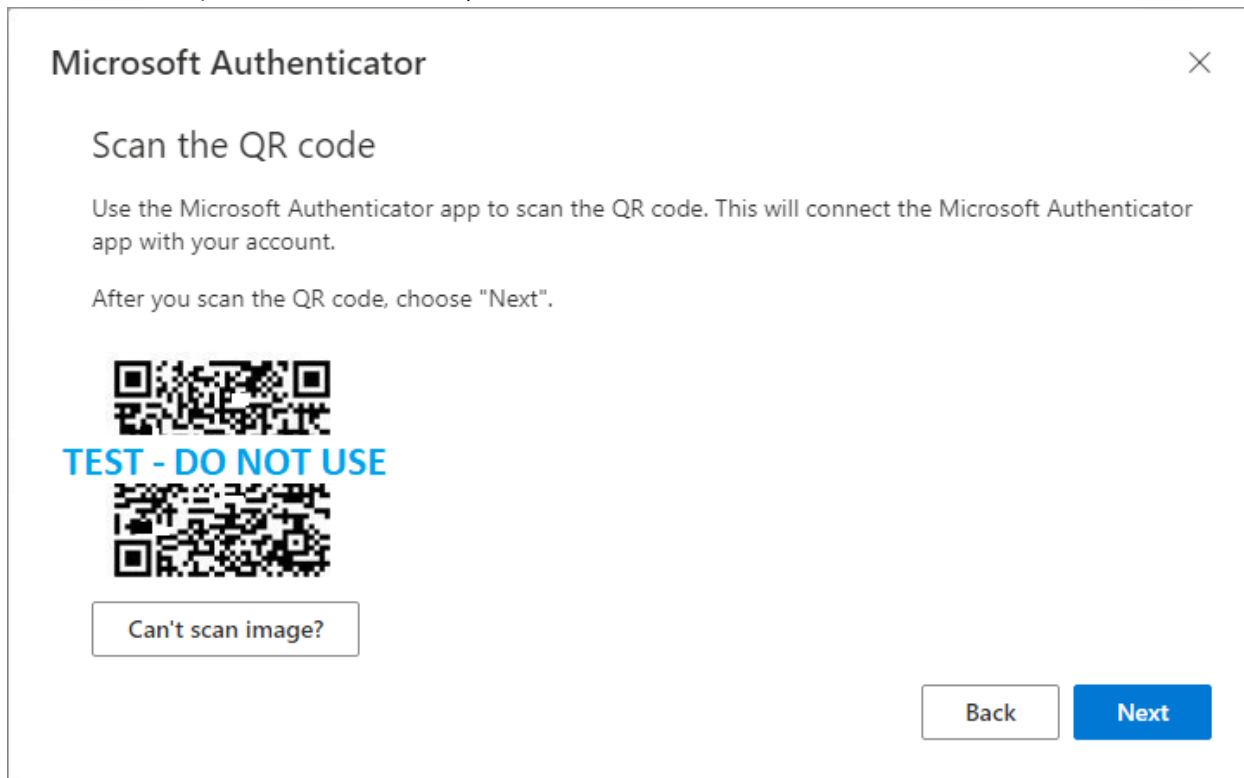


Follow through with the prompts to setup your Microsoft Authenticator. Install the application if not already downloaded, as per the instructions and click **Next**.

Note: Notifications are required to be enabled for the Microsoft Authenticator application to function.



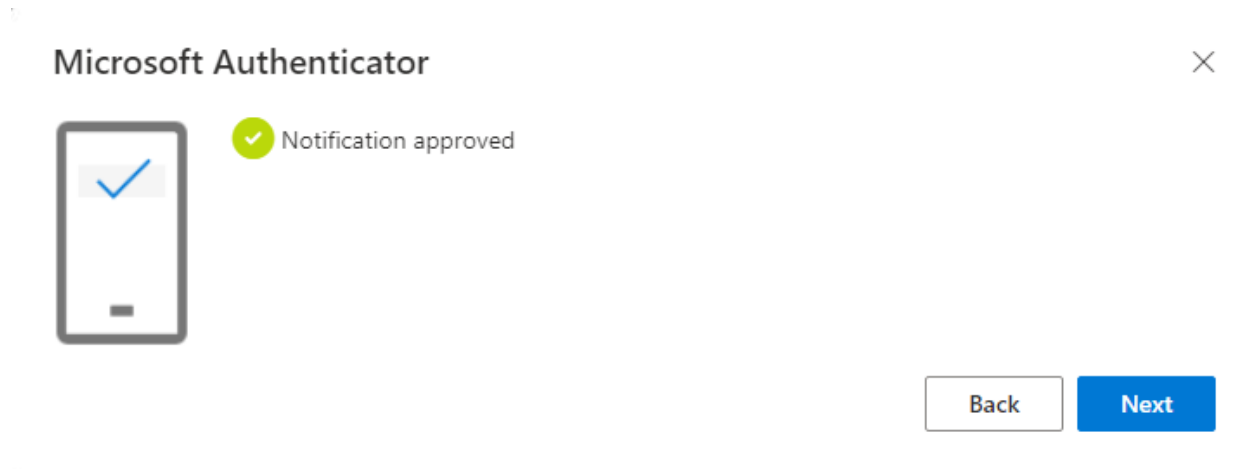
Scan the QR code by clicking the **+** icon in the Microsoft Authenticator, select **Work or School Account** and then **Scan QR code**. Once scanned, click **Next**.



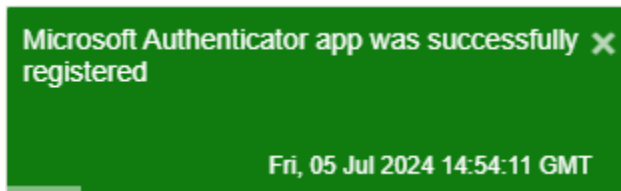


A 2-digit number will be shown, and a notification will be sent to the Microsoft Authenticator app. Enter in the code from the computer into the pop-up that appears on the phone, and click **Yes** to proceed.

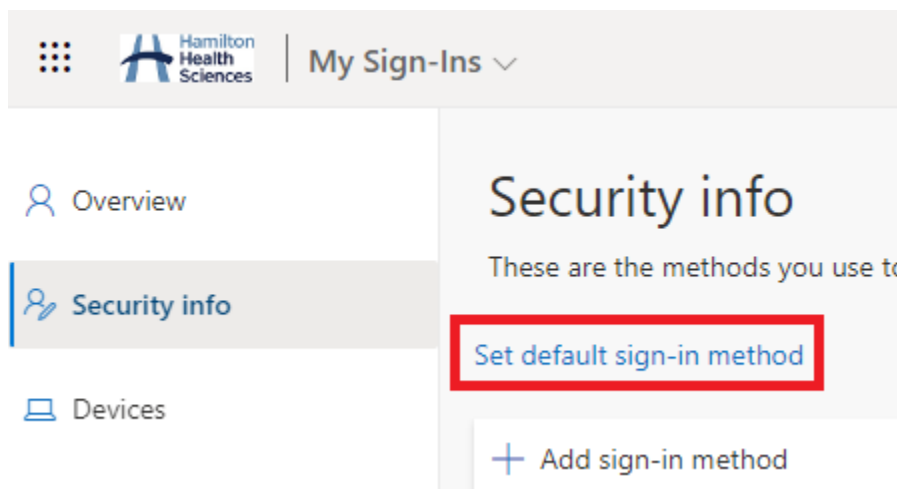
The dialog will show as notification approved, click **Next**.



A green pop-up will appear at the top right of the Security Info page, confirming that the Microsoft Authenticator has been successfully added.



On the main Security Info page, select **Set default sign-in method**.





Choose the **App based authentication – notification** option from the list in the dialog that appears, and click **Confirm**.
